- Developed an MVP: a mobile-responsive, video learning platform, using SvelteKit, TypeScript, and SCSS. Prisma was used as an ORM with a PostgreSQL database. Lucia was used to handle authentication and authorization, including email/password and Discord authentication.
- Accessibility-focused. Correct use of semantic HTML, aria-attributes, and keeping in-mind the use of screen-readers, and structuring the HTML based on that. See [here](#) for an example of a semantically correct LinkedIn post.
- Successfully adapted the Agile workflow, including: working in sprints, using a Kanban board, stand-ups, and being flexible to change priorities if needed.
- Worked with git as a version-control system. Used Github, Gitlab, and Gitea. Created Pull Requests with the changelog format. Worked in a feature-branch git workflow.
- Worked within a monorepo with Turborepo on an eCommerce site. Responsible for the admin-facing app. Used Next.js, plain CSS, and Storybook; ensured the site works with JavaScript off.
- Used Penpot and Figma to create lofi designs to iterate on during development.

- Trained to use Flutter and Android Studio in 2 weeks before fully immersed in the project, working with a team of senior developers to develop a cross-platform mobile app using Flutter. Continuously learn Flutter independently throughout the project.

- Responsible for the admin app design and functionality: taking orders from database and displaying it to the app, editing orders, flagging orders as 'Done' which also updates the customer app.

- Created a locally hosted eCommerce WordPress website powered with WooCommerce, with custom theme and CSS. Contains admin and client functionalities.
